Spring Means Seasonal Allergies!

Spring means flower buds and blooming trees. But if you're one of the millions of people who have seasonal allergies, it also means sneezing, congestion, a runny nose, and other bothersome symptoms. Seasonal allergies can make you miserable. But before you settle for plastic flowers and artificial turf, try these simple strategies to keep seasonal allergies under control: Reduce exposure to allergy triggers - stay indoors on dry, windy days. The best time to go outside is after a good rain, which helps clear pollen from the air. Take extra steps when pollen counts are high. Seasonal allergy signs and symptoms can flare up when there's lots of pollen in the air. Try an over-the-counter remedy. Several types of nonprescription medications can help ease allergy symptoms.
