

In high school, Carole was active on the Drill Team, the National Honor Society, earned 2nd Place in District Shorthand, and was listed in Who's Who. She graduated in 1962. She took piano lessons from elementary school through college. Carole and her future husband. Jim. were members of the Silsbee Methodist Church and were married there on June 1, 1968. She occasionally served as the church organist. Carole earned a Business degree from Lamar University in 1966, and became a certified teacher and was a member of the Kappa Delta Sorority. After their honeymoon, they lived in Houston, where Carole worked as a secretary at Shell, and Jim worked at Texaco. When Jim joined the Army and was stationed at the Pentagon, Carole worked as a secretary to Patent Attorneys in Crystal City, Virginia. After Jim's military service, they returned to Houston, and Carole resumed working for Patent Attorneys until the birth of their son, James, in 1972. Their daughter, Julie, was born in 1974. Carole became a stay-at-home mom until the children reached high school. She drew daily lunchbox illustrations for them during their elementary and junior high years and taught piano to many students. Later, she began substitute teaching at The Briarwood School, eventually becoming a full-time teacher and later Head of School, a position she held for over 20 years until her retirement in 2020. During that time, Carole and her close friend Sally Holy were regular early morning runners; in later years, they walked. Carole served twice as President of her Homeowners' Association and served a term as President of HBIDA (Houston Branch of the International Dyslexia Association). Carole drew many small pictures for Christmas that she framed and gave away annually. She is known as Grandmother to her only granddaughter, Elliott, who is studying Government and minoring in Business at the University of Texas.
