SEPTEMBER 7-13 | ASSISTED LIVING WEEK

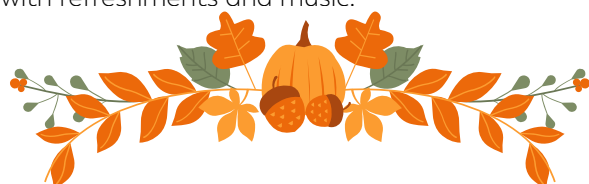
