The third of four children, she grew up in a close-knit family that valued hard work and service. Her brothers proudly served in the military, and her family’s canning business supported soldiers during World War II. Her grandfather, Gustave “Gus” Lange, founded The Lange Canning Company, which grew from a small operation into a thriving business. The company was later led by her mother, Florence, one of the few pioneering women in business at the time. Judith went on to raise four accomplished daughters, instilling in them the same values of dedication, perseverance, and community involvement that shaped her own life. She remained active in the Girl Scouts, serving as a leader as her daughters advanced through the organization. Professionally, Judith retired from Houston Community College’s Media Department, where she helped develop and manage the department, ensuring faculty and students across multiple campuses had the technology and support they needed to succeed. A devoted supporter of the March of Dimes in honor of her eldest daughter, a nurse for premature babies, Judith’s leadership and determination helped her campus raise significant funds year after year. Affectionately known as “Mimi,” she is the proud matriarch of six grandchildren, five great-grandchildren, and numerous beloved pets. She treasures her family deeply, often wearing her custom “Mimi” T-shirts and enjoying a digital photo frame that keeps her connected to the smiling faces of loved ones near and far. Judith’s life is a testament to faith, family, and service, and she continues to inspire all who know her with her warmth, strength, and unwavering dedication.

How The Turkey Came To Be a Associated with Thanksgiving!



Turkey became associated with Thanksgiving due to practical reasons, its abundance in North America, and its promotion as a holiday staple by writers like Sarah Josepha Hale. While wild turkey was likely present at the first feast, its role as the centerpiece was cemented in the mid-19th century when President Lincoln declared Thanksgiving a national holiday. By then, the large bird was a popular and economical choice for feeding families at a celebratory meal. Turkeys were plentiful in the region when the Pilgrims arrived, however. Estimates put the total number of wild turkeys in North America at more than 10 million before European settlement began. The myth that turkey was on the menu at the first Thanksgiving in 1621 is not historically accurate, though wild turkey may have been among the foods served. It wasn't until the mid-1800s that it became the central, iconic symbol of the holiday meal. The strong association with the holiday began to form much later. Most Americans who celebrate Thanksgiving eat turkey with their holiday meal, perhaps alongside other favorite dishes such as mashed potatoes, green bean casserole and pumpkin pie. The turkey's size and prominence on the table came to symbolize the abundance and harvest that the holiday celebrates.

"November Celebrates National Happy Hour Day"

Happy Hour is celebrated often at Parkway Place. The event occurs on the 1st and 2nd Thursday of each month. It is one of the most enjoyable activity attended by residents and families. National Happy Hour Day is celebrated annually on November 12th to recognize the tradition of happy hour. The day is a fun occasion to enjoy drinks and appetizers, either at a local bar or restaurant, or by hosting a celebration at home. The term "happy hour" originated with the U.S. Navy in the early 20th century and gained popularity through the 1920s, especially during Prohibition. Join healthcare for a special November Happy Hour called "Thankful Songs of Gratitude" by David La Duca in honor of this day. Every November 12, there's a reason for drink lovers to raise a glass and toast. National Happy Hour Day is not just about enjoying a beverage; it's about cherishing social ties and making memories.

Veterans Day! We Thank You For Your Service!

November is the month that we honor and thank our veterans for serving our country. Parkway Traditional Veterans Day ceremony will be held on Tuesday November 11th at 11:00 AM in the Auditorium. Our local heroes will be recognized for time served in the U.S. military. Veterans Day originated as Armistice Day on November 11, 1919, to commemorate the end of World War I. In 1954, the name was changed to Veterans Day to include veterans from all wars, and the day serves to thank living veterans for their patriotism and sacrifice. The holiday recognizes the courage, dedication, and willingness to serve that veterans have demonstrated. Many observances include a moment of silence at 11 a.m. to remember those who have served. Communities often hold parades to honor parades and ceremonies to honor veterans. People may fly the U.S. flag, and some use yellow ribbons as a symbol of support for those in the armed services.

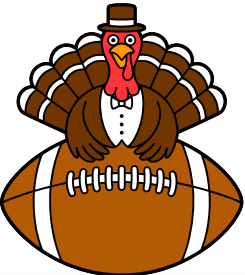

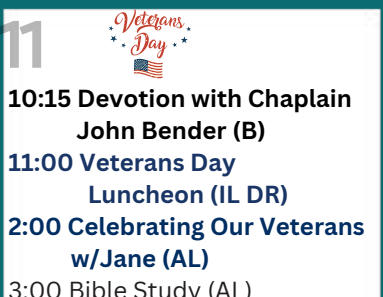

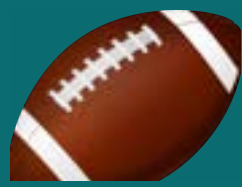
